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### The Venue



Here's some information we thought you'd ought to know:

- The live final is being held on Saturday 14th September 2024 at 1532 Performing Arts Centre, Elton Road, Bristol, BS8 1SJ
- The competition will consist of six categories. The Showcase category will not be judged or have a category winner.
- The venue has a capacity of 245 seated.
- Sponsors will be able to access the venue from anytime from 10am. Public will have access to the foyer from 1pm. Doors open the theatre at 1:30pm and the show will start at 2pm. There will be two 20 minute breaks scheduled for the audience and competitors to come browse your glorious stalls.

 The venue is wheelchair accessible for both audience and competitors, including lifts and accessible facilities. Front row seats can be reserved on request to those with access requirements. If you would like to detail any access requirements as part of your judging role, have any questions about access or want to discuss this further please email us.

#### Directions

The Centre is just off Clifton Triangle on Elton Road.

There is on-street parking directly outside the venue and on adjacent roads. Charges may apply so please check signage. There are also nearby car parks located on Trenchard Street and Jacob Wells Road.

There are so many forms of pole and dance; we want to see them all... whatever that means to you.


#### **Our Promise**




